In the interest of New Mexico workers, I strongly urge you to **vote** *NO* on HB 297, the Workforce and Economic Prosperity Act. Despite its name, this bill would be incredibly damaging to the New Mexico economy and would hinder our recovery from the Covid-19 economic downturn. Jobs and opportunities are created by private businesses, many of them small businesses, which would suffer under the rules and regulations handed down by the council created by HB 297. The clean energy sector will grow and develop when it is economically feasible. Government intervention and direction will make that more difficult by increasing the complexity and costs associated with developing that industry.
